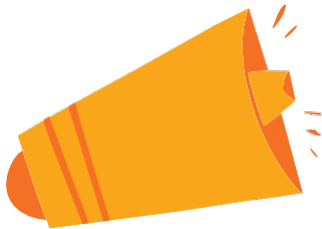

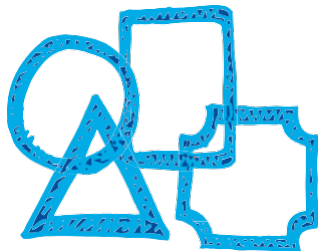
GO-GETTER

- At an age-appropriate level, help your troop plan out their year **OR** for IRM/Juliette girls, work with your caregiver to plan out your Girl Scout year.
- Reach your Fall Product Program goal **AND** reach your Cookie Program goal (first-year Girl Scouts may complete this requirement without participating in the Fall Product Program).



INNOVATOR

- Earn any STEM or Outdoors badge **OR** work towards your Bronze, Silver, or Gold Award.
- Register and participate in any GSUSA or GSCTX program or event, virtually or in-person. Visit www.gsctx.org/events for more information.



RISK-TAKER

- Earn a patch through one of the GSCTX Council Patch Pack, Monthly Patch, **OR** other Council Patch programs. Visit www.gsctx.org/patchpack and www.gsctx.org/patchprogram for more information.
- Earn at least three Daisy Petals, complete at least three Badges, **OR** finish any Journey.



LEADER

- Earn one of the new 2020 badges for your Program Level (Civics/Democracy, Entrepreneur, Automotive Engineering, or STEM Career Exploration).
- Help another girl register for Girl Scouts **OR** Participate in a service project that benefits the larger community.

Super G.I.R.L. – FAQ

What does a Girl Scout need to do to earn the Super G.I.R.L. award?

To be awarded the Super G.I.R.L., a Girl Scout must complete all 8 requirements.

How were the overall requirements determined for Super G.I.R.L.?

Using data from various sources, including the feedback from the Girl Scouts Voices Count survey of girls, caregivers, and adult volunteers, GSCTX chose the requirements that would potentially have the biggest impact in ensuring a successful Girl Scout year for a troop. Requirements this year were also adjusted to allow for virtual or in-person settings, as guidelines allow.

What does a Girl Scout get for being a Super G.I.R.L.?

Super G.I.R.L.s will receive a certificate acknowledging their hard work. Super G.I.R.L.s can purchase a pin at the GSCTX shop and wear it with pride on the front of their uniform.

How does a Girl Scout apply for the Super G.I.R.L. designation?

A troop leader, caregiver of the Girl Scout, or older Girl Scout fills out the Super Award HTML form online at www.gsctx.org/super. The form will be available by March 1, 2021.

What is the deadline to apply for the Super G.I.R.L. award?

The deadline to complete and submit an application for the award is May 15, 2021. Girls will be notified by June 2021 if they earned the Super G.I.R.L. award.

Will someone be checking to see if the Girl Scout has completed the requirements for Super G.I.R.L.?

Requirements will be checked by staff to receive the certificate. The GSCTX shop will sell Super G.I.R.L. pins based on the honor system.

How do the pins work for Super G.I.R.L.?

The “full get-up” Super G.I.R.L. pin consists of the original All-Star Trooper gold Texas pin. It has an embroidered star backing, with a different colored embroidered star color for each program grade level. The pin will have an additional G.I.R.L. disc that will go behind the embroidered star. Pins can be worn with pride by girls on the front of the uniform.

Can a girl get the Super G.I.R.L. award if her troop is not a Super Troop?

Absolutely. None of the Super G.I.R.L. award requirements necessitate troop involvement, and additionally, IRM/Juliette Girl Scouts may also participate. If a Girl Scout earns Super G.I.R.L. and her troop is not a Super Troop, the Girl Scout or her caregiver can purchase the pin/star/disc combination at the GSCTX shop. If her troop is a Super Troop, and she receives the pin/star combination, but the troop does not purchase the disc, she or her caregiver can purchase this separately.

How often can this award be earned?

Girls may earn this award/pin again each year.
